## **Golden Expectations**

Children will follow our 4 school golden expectations:

Ready - Respect - Safe - Honesty

House points and/or class rewards will be used to celebrate children who are following these expectations and our school values.

#### Uniform

Please make sure correct uniform and new PE kit is worn at all times and ensure it is named.

#### Bags

Tewin book bag only (rucksacks are for year 6 only)

Tewin school PE bag

\*If you are adding a keyring to book bags, please ensure it is very small as large keyrings can prevent the book drawers closing properly.

#### PE

PE will take place on a **Monday** and a **Tuesday**. Please ensure your child arrives in the correct PE kit (named) on these days.

If your new PE kit hasn't arrived yet, please wear the old PE kit until you have the new one.

#### Art and DT

Please could your child bring in a **named** old oversized T-shirt, shirt or apron that they could wear during Art and DT activities? This will ensure their school uniform is not ruined by paint stains.



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#### Other items

Please ensure your child comes to school with a named water bottle every day.

Children can bring in their own pencil case if they wish but this must be small as these need to fit in their drawers and wipeable as they get very dirty. It is not necessary for them to have one as all resources will be provided, this is purely optional.

Pencil cases may contain the following items only:

- Pens suitable for writing. Children will write in blue pens in lessons but may have a couple of others for general use
- A rubber
- Small selection of highlighters
- A sharpener which must contain the shavings
- A small selection of colouring pencils

Please note that extra items may be removed.

### Homework

Regular homework will not be set but children will be expected to read as often as possible and practice times tables and spellings as required.

A small project may be sent home relating to our Topic which we hope children will be inspired to complete.
