Art

English

Science

Go for a walk outside to explore autumn.

- What you see?

Music

Listen carefully to sounds you might hear in autumn - rustling leaves, wind blowing and footsteps on crunchy leaves. Use simple instruments, body percussion or even household items to imitate autumn sounds.

Science

Draw an animal you might see in autumn.



Maths

Use autumn colours or objects to make patterns.
For example, red leaf, yellow leaf, red leaf, yellow leaf.

Draw your pattern and continue it.
