



Activities linked to our topics – Comparing animals and what is the weather like in the UK?

Art

Create an animal picture using only primary colours and the colours you mix from them.



English

Think of a new animal that no one has seen before.
Make up a fun name for it.

Draw a picture of your animal.


Label or write 2/3 sentences about your animal:

- What it looks like (colour, size, special features)
- What it likes to do or eat
- Where it lives

Science

Draw a Venn diagram and sort the animals into groups of your choice,

Example groups: “animals that like cold” and “animals that like hot” or “animals that live on land” and “animals that live in water”.



Geography

Be a weather detective:
For one week, look outside every day and record what the weather is like. You can:

- Write words: sunny, rainy, windy, cloudy...
- Draw pictures: sun, clouds, raindrops...
- Use symbols: ☀️, ☁️, 🌧️, 🌬️...

Geography

If you know that rain is expected, make a simple rain gauge at home to collect and observe the rainfall. This activity will learn about weather and measurement in a hands-on way.

Science

Create a poster about your favourite animal.
Describe its habitat, what it likes to eat, and it's features.
